SPRING SAFETY TIP

Use a **T-CLOCS** walk-around for the best way to know you've done everything you can to make your ride safe. **T-CLOCS** is an acronym checklist made by the [Motorcycle Safety Foundation](#) specifically for checking the functionality of a bike in every fashion. It checks **T**ires and **W**heels, **C**ontrols, **L**ights and **E**lectrics, **O**ils and fluids, **C**hassis, and **S**tands. Once you've gone through that, you can enjoy your first ride without the worry of your bike giving out from under you.
